### Report/Justify an Absence on the Mozaik Portal

To report an absence or justify an absence entered by a teacher, you need to connect to your Mozaik Account either on a web browser or on the mobile application.

You will be notified if your child requires vaccination in the upcoming days either by email or by letter delivered to your child to bring home.

Another evacuation practice will take place under the supervision of the Richmond Fire Department during the month of October. Two lockdown practices will also be held in the month of November.

This service is no longer offered by transportation. It will be your responsibility to transport your student to their friends' house, workplace or other.

### **Picking Up Your Child During School Hours**

Please notify the Main Office, either by phone, by Mozaik Portal or by email, if you need to pick up your child during school hours. When the student comes to the Main Office to sign out, we require written or verbal permission from a parent or guardian prior to allowing your child to leave the premises.

### **Procedure for Absentees**

If your child is absent for any reason, please justify the absence using the Mozaik Portal before the start of classes.

### **Lost & Found**

The lost & found box is now located in the Main Office. If nothing has been claimed by the end of each month, it will be taken to the local fripperie.
