Every school year, we prepare all staff and students in case of an emergency by holding evacuation and lockdown practices. During September, there will be two fire drill practices. Another evacuation will take place in early October under the supervision of the Richmond Fire Department. Two lockdown practices will also be held.

School Pictures

The school pictures will be on September 24th. It is important that all students be here as these photos are used to make their student IDs. If your child is not present on school picture day, there will be a make-up date on November 4th for individual pictures.

Extra-Curricular Activities & Late Buses

We are pleased to be able to provide students with a full range of extra-curricular activities this school year. Please consult the RRHS website in order to obtain the list of activities that will be available to students. We encourage all students to take part in one or more activities of their choice. There will be late buses available to limited locations. This will depend on the activities being offered each day and a schedule will follow soon. Please note that students MUST sign up a WEEK in advance, as we reserve the buses for the following week.

Permission to Leave School Grounds

Permission forms are now available at the Main Office for parents to give permission to your child in Secondary 3, 4 and 5 and/or 16 years or age and older to leave school grounds during lunch hour.

Private Vehicle on School Grounds

Permission forms to fill out if your child is driving a private vehicle on school grounds are now available in the Main Office.

Procedure for Absentees

If your child is absent for any reason, please contact the school before the start of classes. To report an absence, please use the Parent Portal, call (819) 826-3702 extension 1; please leave a DETAILED message if there is no answer, or you can also email rrhsabsences@etsb.qc.ca This will avoid extra work for the school. If you know in advance that your child is going to be absent from school, please call, e-mail or you can write a note to be delivered to the main office. When you are contacting the school, please give your child's full name and the reason for his/her absence.

Transportation

Please note that there will be no temporary bus passes issued again this school year.
