### **Outdoor Phys. Ed Classes:**

Starting January 26th, weather permitting, our Physical & Health Education (PHE) classes will take place outdoors in accordance with the schedule. The new PHE schedule will be shared with students via Google Classroom soon.

To ensure students are comfortable and prepared, we kindly ask that they come to school with appropriate outdoor gear, including warm clothing, a jacket, gloves, snow pants, and any other suitable items for outdoor activities. If your child is missing any of these items, the PHE department has some extra gear available, just in case.

Outdoor PHE classes provide an excellent opportunity for students to enjoy fresh air, develop skills, and engage in physical activity in a different setting. We will continue to monitor weather conditions closely and make adjustments as needed to prioritize the safety and well-being of all students.
